

# NZAC Travel and Accommodation Guide

In this guide, you will find information about the venue address, parking, nearby hotels, dining options, convenient parking facilities, and transportation details.

## **Venue address:**

The event is being held at Shed 6, 4 Queens Wharf, Jervois Quay, Wellington, New Zealand.

## **Parking and public transport**

- [Wilson car park at Queens Wharf](#) located under Shed 6 has mobility parking spaces available.
- There is a drop-off zone close to the entrance, accessible from Jervois Quay.
- There are Metlink bus stops in the area.

## ***Walking***

The entrance to Shed 6 sits within the TSB Arena. You can walk south along the waterfront to the venue.

### **Wellington Railway station**

You can walk from the station along the waterfront to Shed 6. For a scenic route, exit out the main concourse, cross over to Waterloo Quay and walk along Lady Elizabeth Lane, then onto the Commonwealth Walkway which leads to Shed 6 (next to TSB Arena).

### **Wellington Airport**

There are airport express buses available from Wellington Airport. Get off Lambton Quay Cable Car Lane bus stop and cross the road to Grey Street. Follow Grey Street until you come to the crossing at Jervois Quay Motorway. Cross over and walk through Queen's Wharf, turn right and you will see the entrance of Shed 6 nestled between the TSB arena.

## **Accessibility**

### ***Wheelchair access***

- Shed 6 has wheelchair access available
- Accessible seat locations differ for each event because the venue is multipurpose.
- For event-specific seats, you can visit the event page on the Ticketmaster website or contact Venues Wellington.
- Wheelchairs are available at the venue but require you to give advanced notice so they can ensure they are on-site during the event.
- There are ramps available inside the venue.

Low-cost accommodation located in the Island Bay area of Wellington. The Home of Compassion also includes a marae style room that offers **\$15.00** per night (including breakfast). First in, first serve – please consider sharing a twin room.

The venue is booked out for NZAC members only so this offers additional opportunity to network with other Members' with lounge and kitchen areas.

There is a direct bus that goes from this accommodation to the venue. Catch the Number 1 bus from The Parade in Island Bay and get off at the Lambton Quay at Hunter Street stop,

### **Food and Drink**

Morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea and canapés are included in your event ticket. Breakfast and dinner is not included in the booking. The Wellington waterfront offers a huge selection of eateries, here are some of the recommended options:

*Breakfast:*

#### **Karaka Café**

Located within the Wharewaka Function Centre, 8 minutes walk from Shed 6, overlooking the Whairepo Lagoon, Karaka Café is proudly operated by the Retimanu whānau, who are of Māori & Pacifica decent. Proudly boasting the taste and aromas of Māori flavours through their cafe style foods and delicious barista coffee. A relaxed café with both indoor and outdoor eating areas. Highly recommended!

#### **Mojo Waterfront**

The closest Mojo to the conference venue. A nifty little café for breakfast options and great coffee, a 5 minute walk from Shed 6.

#### **Dockside Restaurant and Bar**

Located opposite Shed 6 with a scenic view of the dock and harbour, Dockside is an upmarket dinner option with a large over-water deck area (that can also be covered in Wellington's unpredictable weather), giving that Al fresco feel!
